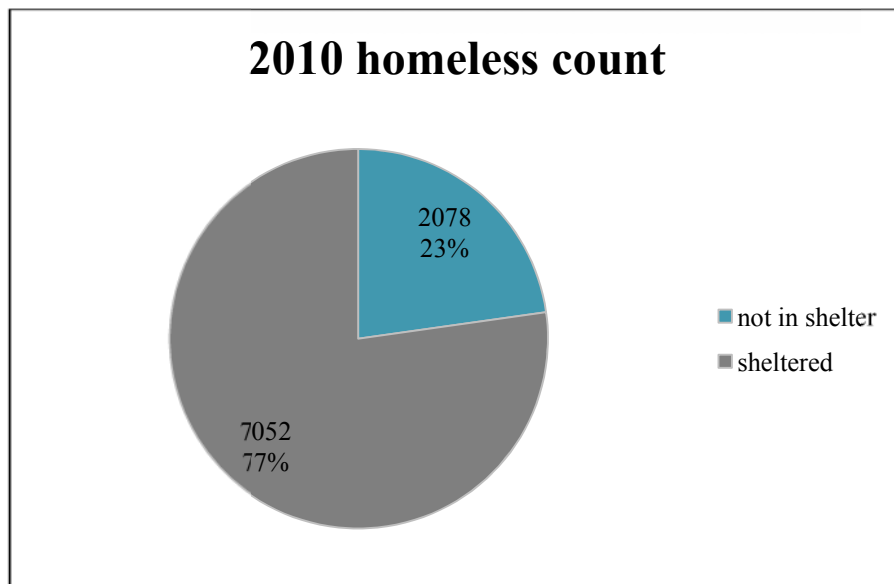

2010 Homeless Census

Number of homeless

The Coalition has counted 9,130 homeless people in Louisville. The census includes people who were in homeless shelters, on the street or those who received services from homeless providers. The census covers the period from Jan 1, 2010 to Dec 31, 2010. Coalition homeless count is more inclusive than the homeless count used by US Dept. of Housing. HUD counts only the people who stay in shelters.

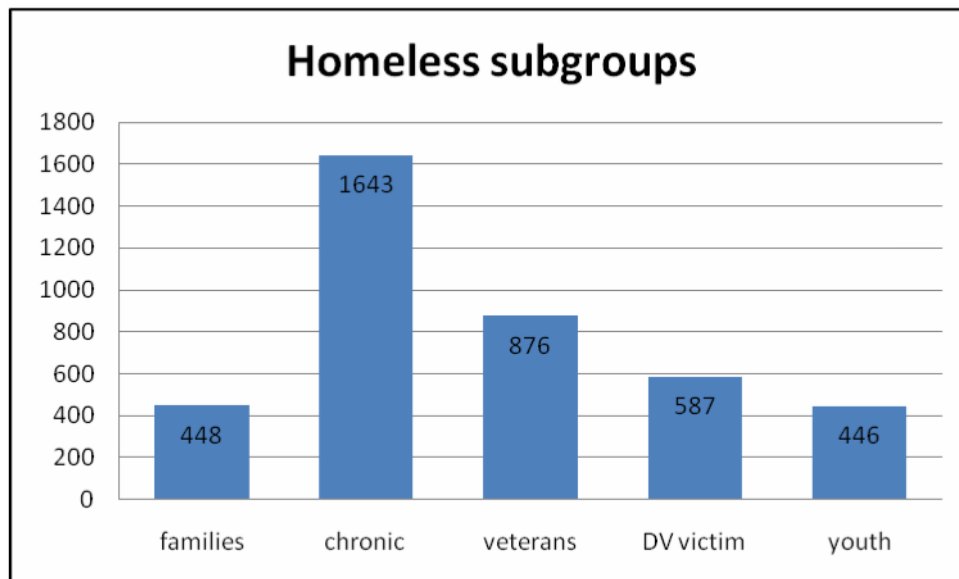

Homeless subpopulations

The subpopulation counts apply only to the 7,766 people in shelters. We do not collect this data for the unsheltered homeless. The counts are comparable with the previous year.

Homeless families

Coalition counted 448 homeless families that stayed in homeless shelters, a 14% decrease from previous year. These families had 1,323 adults and children. However, the last JCPS report (2009-10 school year) identified 10,555 homeless children in the public schools. The difference between these two counts indicates that a substantial number of homeless families do not use the homeless shelters.
