Expanded Eligibility Under the Save Lives Act

These groups are now eligible for a COVID-19 vaccine:

All Categories of Veterans:

- Regardless of Character of Discharge, Never activated National Guard, Reserve and Coast Guard

Veterans - Anyone who served in the U.S. military

Spouses of Veterans - Spouses include:

- Same-sex and common-law marriages, Widow or widower of a Veteran, Individuals who characterize their relationship as spousal can receive the vaccine.

Caregivers of a Veteran:

- Family member or friend who provides care, or helps the Veteran with personal needs (feeding, bathing, or dressing) and helps with tasks (shopping or transportation).
- CHAMPVA Recipients
- Spouses or children of permanently and totally disabled Veterans or Veterans who have died from service-connected disabilities. Recipients must be at least 18 years of age.
