The Coalition's Path to Action series invites Louisvillians to learn about and discuss homelessness and housing.

Today's Topic: How Did We Get Here? (Wednesday, 9/6, 5:30-7pm, at West Sixth NuLu)

- **MYTH:** Homelessness is caused by a bad choice or series of bad choices made out of personal failures.
- **FACT:** Statistics from across the country show that homelessness is most strongly correlated with the availability or lack of low-cost housing, even when tested against mental illness, drug use, poverty, weather, generosity of public assistance, and low-income mobility. (Source: *Homelessness Is a Housing Problem*, Gregg Colburn). Therefore, homelessness is a policy and funding choice made by governments, not a personal choice by individuals.
- Since the Great Depression, our government has incentivized and prioritized homeownership—mostly for white people—through these choices, formalized through policy decisions:
 - Who deserved (and didn't deserve) access to capital and property
 - Where that capital could (and couldn't) flow
 - The prioritization of homeownership over renting
- Housing is the answer to homelessness—specifically housing that poor people can afford.
