

## Guide to FY26 Louisville Continuum of Care Scoring Process

**\*Remember ALL projects should submit your Supportive Services Agreement when completing your project application!**

**\*\* New this year\*\* All project applications and relevant document uploads will be submitted using Jotform ([Start your Application](#)), excluding the e-Snaps submission. ### Overview

Scoring rubrics have been prepared to score projects on a range of objective and narrative factors. These scoring rubrics will be completed in part by the applying organization/agency and in part by CFH staff. Rubrics have been designed to reflect HUDs stated priorities, metrics and system performance measures in the FY2026 NOFO. Objective metrics will state what data is measured along with all scoring criteria and CoC averages (when applicable). Narrative responses will include scoring criteria for each question. Scores from these rubrics will be used to determine the Louisville Continuum of Care project ranking which, in a notable change from past funding cycles, includes all project types, excluding CoC Planning funds.

To review every question your project will be scored on, you will need to utilize the applicable scoring rubric pack. JotForm, where the project application is hosted this year, will only feed you relevant questions depending on your project type as you navigate through the form. You will be able to save your progress and return later to submit.

### Submission Deadlines

**July 22, 2026** - Deadline to submit all project applications to the Louisville Continuum of Care.

**August 3, 2026** - Draft eSnaps Deadline

**August 16, 2026** - Final eSnaps Deadline

### Scoring Rubrics

**IF your project is PSH, RRH, Joint TH-RRH or TH and is a standard renewal**, you will be scored using the Renewal PH/TH Projects rubric.

**IF your project is a new SSO project**, you will be scored using the New SSO Project rubric.

**IF your project is applying for a transition grant**, you will be scored using the New PH/TH Project (Reallocation) rubric.

**IF your project will be a reallocation of currently funded PSH, RRH, Joint TH-RRH or TH**, you will be scored using the New PH/TH Project (Reallocation) rubric.

**IF your project will be a reallocation of a SSO project**, you will be scored using the New SSO Project (Reallocation) rubric.

**IF your project is a new PSH, RRH or TH project**, you will be scored using the New PH/TH Project rubric.

**IF your project has not yet completed a full operating year**, review the New PH/TH Project rubric.

### Checklist of scoring materials

By June 29, 2026

- APR submission of all currently funded CoC projects. Report range: 4/1/2025 to 3/31/2026. Submit via email to Chloe Chaplin at [cchaplin@louhomeless.org](mailto:cchaplin@louhomeless.org)
- For VSPs: Submission of data source comparable to HMIS APR for the period 4/1/2025 to 3/31/2026 to Chloe

By July 10, 2026

- Intent to apply due via Google Forms

By July 22, 2026

- JotForm Application
- Submission of Supportive Services Agreement via JotForm document upload
  - Reminder: The Supportive Services Agreement is the participation agreement signed by the client (Case Management Agreement, Occupancy Agreement, Lease, etc.)
- Supplemental Budget Form via JotForm document upload
  - If you are using in-kind match, submit your Match MOUs as well.
- (New Projects ONLY)** Financial policies via JotForm document upload
- Other document uploads that **may be** required through JotForm are: commitment letters verifying housing or healthcare resources used to subsidize the cost of units and/or services rendered; a data source from a similar project type if you are a new agency applying for CoC funding for the first time

By August 3, 2026

- Draft e-Snaps application

By August 17, 2026

- Final e-Snaps application
